

## Fair Political Practices Commission to Investigate Lily Mei for Potential Violations of State Election Law

As of October 22, 2020, Fremont Mayor Lily Mei is now being investigated by state authorities for potentially violating state election law.

/EINPresswire.com/ -- On October 22, 2020, Chief of the Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (FPPC) Galena West confirmed in public documents that state authorities have opened an investigation into Lily Mei's campaign financial statements for potential violations of state election law. This ranges from incomplete/inaccurate reporting to potentially accepting double contributions or conduit contributions from donors.

On October 23, 2020, the FPPC confirmed that Lily Mei and Lily Mei for Fremont Mayor will both be investigated and that additional allegations have been merged with the existing case.

This letter is to notify you that the Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission will investigate the allegation(s), under the jurisdiction of the Commission, of the sworm complaint you submitted in the above-referenced mater. You will next receive notification from us upon final disposition of the case. However, please be advised that at this time we have not made any determination about the validity of the allegation(s) you have made or about the culpability, if any, of the person(s) you identify in your complaint.

Please note that elected city councilmembers are not required to disqualify themselves from participating in decisions affecting the source of a campaign contribution while sitting in their capacity as elected councilmembers. (Section 87108(c), 82030(b)(1)). Note that the only exception is Section 84308 that requires persons in an appointed capacity to refrain from participating in certain decisions that might affect the source of a campaign contribution. Section 84300 knower does not apply to local government agencies whose members are directly elected by the voters, such as the elected city council. Additionally, the Act's prohibition on foreign contributions does not extend to candidates. Section 8430 applies only to state or local ballot measures. Therefore, we will not pursue the conflict of interest and foreign contribution allegations further.
